The Task

Create the front page of a newspaper. Think about where the story in your book is set. How would newspapers look in this place? Your newspaper should include articles based on events that occur in the novel, the weather of the town where the story is set, games (word search, crossword puzzle), or anything else you feel is important.

Check-list for a successful project

□ Includes the title of the book, the author and the book series at the top of the page.

□ The newspaper has a name and a date.

- The newspaper has a major story with a headline and the main article.
 The text of the main article is 150-200 words.
 There are 2 minor stories.

- The minor stories both have headlines and articles.
 Each minor story is 50-60 words.
 Includes pictures relevant to all the stories.

□ All articles are in your own words.

Useful Tips

- You may draw the pictures, cut and paste from newpapers and magazines or even take actual photos that relate to the scenes in the book!
- You can add anything else that you think a newspaper needs to have. Use your imagination. It is in your hands to make your project stands out.
