Check-list for a successful project

- Each description is no more than 50 words.

Useful Tips

- For pictures of scenes from the story, you can draw the pictures, use pictures from newspapers and magazines or even take actual photos that are related to the scenes in the book!
- For family photos, consider the physical appearance of the characters, the environment and the era. You can also use real photos of people.
- Use your imagination. It is in your hands to make your project stand out. Originality and creativity are key!
